



A LOW-DOSE TRIPLE COMBINATION DRENCH
ALLIANCE is a white/ML/clear triple combination oral drench for the management of internal parasites in sheep and cattle

- White/ML/clear triple combination
- Low-dose oral drench
- 1 mL/10kg for sheep and cattle
- 14 day sheep meat withhold
- 10 day cattle meat withhold
- Ideal quarantine drench

Registered for:

ALLIANCE controls internal parasites in sheep and cattle, including tapeworm in sheep. It is a short-acting white/ML/clear triple combination oral drench.

ALLIANCE contains the drench actives oxfendazole (white), levamisole (clear) and abamectin (ML/mectin). Oxfendazole is the most potent of the white drenches. Levamisole has retained efficacy against *Cooperia* species, worms that commonly show resistance to other drench families in cattle. Abamectin belongs to one of the best drench families for controlling *Ostertagia* species.

Triple combinations are best practice for drench resistance management, and are ideal for use as a quarantine drench.

ALLIANCE is a low-dose formulation in sheep.

ALLIANCE also aids in the supplementation of selenium and cobalt.

Withholding times:

Sheep – Meat: 14 days

Cattle – Meat: 10 days

Milk: 35 days

Dose rate:

1 mL/10kg in sheep and cattle

CAUTION: Do not use in lambs under 20kg liveweight or calves under 100kg liveweight. Do not use with milk or milk-feeders, or while calves are suckling.
